NEW ARTICLE

66.10.0 UNIFORM VARIANCE - Wrestlers may wear a one-piece singlet as outlined in the NFHS wrestling rule book, or a two-piece outfit consisting of close-fitting “fight shorts” and a short-sleeved compression top. No combination of the two will be allowed. Wrestling teams must adhere to all other uniform regulations.

66.68.0 UNIFORM VARIANCE - Wrestlers shall wear any shoe deemed appropriate by the coach, activities coordinator, and/or wrestling official. Wrestlers may wear a one-piece singlet as outlined in the NFHS wrestling rule book, or a two-piece outfit consisting of close-fitting “fight shorts” and a short-sleeved compression top. No combination of the two will be allowed. Wrestling teams must adhere to all other uniform regulations.

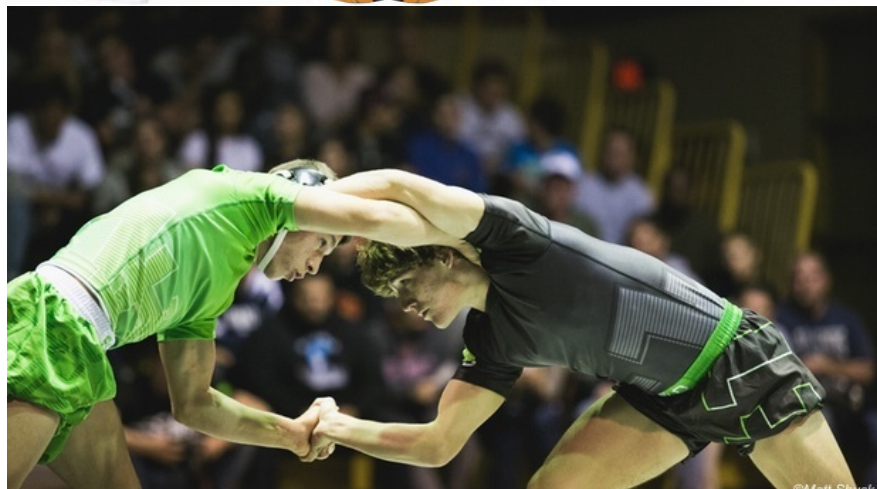
Interpretation of Amendment

As with any uniform, these must be school issued/approved and meet WIAA guidelines for manufacturer trademark.

“Close-fitting fight shorts” – Close fitting fight shorts meet the standards of

- Not extending past the wrestlers knee
- No pockets
- Securable waistband
- No tassels or adornments
- NO Velcro

Interpretation of Amendment

“No combination of the two will be allowed”

- No wearing of a singlet and fight shorts
- Teams may have competitors in either a singlet **OR** compression shirt & fight shorts during the same competition
- Both wrestlers in a match do not need to be wearing the same style of uniform (singlet vs. fight shorts/compression top)

“Short-sleeved compression top”

- Must be short sleeved, cannot extend below elbow.
- Must be athletic grade & moisture wicking material (no regular cotton t shirts)
